

Beer Permit Information

A permit is required for any business that must have a state permit under the provisions of the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Code. The fee shall be set from time to time by the council by resolution and may not exceed the limits established by state law.

Failure to obtain a permit shall be a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00. Each day that a permit is not in force shall be deemed to be a separate offense.

The City renewal fee is due by the expiration date of the license, whether or not the State license has been physically received at the location.
